IAS MEMORANDUM Nr. 37-2010

The Chief, Formal Entry Division, NAIA

Subject : **Submission of Electronic Airline and Airfreight Consolidation Manifest**

This has reference to the implementation of e2m Customs Import Assessment System (IAS) at the Port of NAIA on 23 February 2010. The mandatory submission of advance electronic manifest as a requisite for the filing of import entries (consumption, warehousing, transshipment and informal) is hereby deferred to 23 March 2010. All other procedures in the e2m Customs remain in effect.

For the meantime, the existing alternative facilities of ACOS electronic manifest submission through any of Customs-accredited VASPs or other service providers shall remain operational in accordance with existing regulations in the Port of NAIA and in order to ensure smooth implementation of On-Line Release System (OLRS) for airport cargo warehouses.
