Subject : **Implementation of Import Assessment System (IAS) in All Airport Warehouses in NAIA**

This is with reference to the memorandum issued by Commissioner Napoleon Morales on 01 February 2010 with regards to the effectivity of CMO 27-2009 (Procedures for the Implementation of e2m Customs System – Phase 3: Import Assessment System (IAS) in all Customs Ports Nationwide.”

In connection with the commencement of the implementation of IAS at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) on 23 February 2010, this serves to inform all concerned that IAS shall be implemented in all airport warehouses in NAIA. As such, all airport warehouse operators are hereby reminded to complete their respective registration in the e2m Client Profile Registration System (CPRS) before the implementation commencement date to help ensure the smooth implementation of IAS. Furthermore, airport warehouse operators are encouraged to collaborate with the Value Added Services Providers (VASPs) in setting up the electronic link with the e2m Online Release System (OLRS) in order to benefit from the automated release process being provided by the system.
