- Batch 1 (Informal Entry, Transshipment) Manila International 1. Container Port, Port of Manila, Port of Batangas - January 24 to February 4, 2010.
- Batch 2A (Informal Entry, Transshipment) Subic/Clark, San 2. Fernando, Limay, Legaspi – February 14 to February 25, 2011
- Batch 2B (AEDS, ABMS) Manila International Container Port, 3. Port of Manila, Port of Batangas - February 28 to March 11, 2011
- 4. Batch 3A (AEDS, ABMS) - Subic/Clark, San Fernando, Limay, Legaspi – March 21 to April 1, 2011
- Batch 3B (Informal Entry, Transshipment, AEDS, ABMS) -5. Cebu/Mactan, Davao, Cagayan De Oro/MCT, Iloilo - April 4 to April 15, 2011
- 6. Batch 4 (Informal Entry, Transshipment, AEDS, ABMS) - Tacloban, Zamboanga, Surigao, NAIA - April 18 to April 29, 2011


